



2021 Guest Policies & Procedures

Guests who are not comfortable with these policies should not visit Coney Island. Guests who are unwilling to abide by these policies will be required to leave the park and will not be given refunds.

- ▶ All tickets are non-refundable.
- ▶ No pets are permitted in the park.
- ▶ No glass containers are allowed in the park.
- ▶ No grilling is allowed in the park.
- ▶ No skateboards, scooters, hoverboards, roller skates, or bicycles permitted in Coney Island.
- ▶ No fishing in Lake Como.
- ▶ Entrance to the park constitutes permission for Coney Island to photograph and film you while on the premises and to use those photos and videos for any lawful purpose without any compensation.
- ▶ Guests are not permitted to smoke inside Sunlite Water Adventure. Guests are permitted to smoke in three designated areas: the parking lot, the area on the south side of Moonlite Pavilion, or the area near the river gate.
- ▶ Ohio State law prohibits individuals from bringing alcoholic beverages into Coney Island and the sale of alcoholic beverages to anyone under the legal age. Guests must be at least 21 years of age to purchase, possess, or consume alcoholic beverages at Coney Island. Valid state issued identification or valid driver's license is required upon each person purchasing, possessing, or consuming alcoholic beverages. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted to be brought into Coney Island from any outside source or in any type of container.
- ▶ Coney Island reserves the right to limit the park operating hours including Sunlite Water Adventure and any events.
- ▶ No person may bring or possess any weapons including concealed firearms, sharp objects (including pocket knives and metal chains), or other items that could be considered a weapon on any Coney Island property.
- ▶ All chairs must remain in their designated locations. Guests may bring in their own chair if it is foldable and able to be carried by one person.
